



**Statement of Charging Methodology for  
Use of Energetics Electricity Ltd's  
Distribution System**

**Effective from 1<sup>st</sup> May 2009.**

## **About this Statement**

Energetics Electricity is the trading name of Energetics Electricity Ltd (being the Company), a Licensed Independent Network Operator which owns networks throughout the UK. This statement describes the Use of System Methodology under which authorised users will be charged for use of the Company's distribution system. The methodology applies to charges that become effective after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2009.

## **Licence Obligations**

The Company is obliged under Licence Condition 13, paragraph 1(a) of its Distribution Licence to prepare a statement approved by the Authority, setting out the methodology upon which charges will be levied for the provision of Use of System. We are also obliged to review this statement annually in accordance with Condition 4, paragraph 2(a) in order to comply with paragraph 2(b) and make such modifications to the use of system charging methodology statement that better achieve the "relevant objectives" as defined in paragraph 3 of Condition 13.

## **Charging Methodology**

Energetics Electricity charges are governed by a Relative Price Control (RPC) as per the Licence Condition BA1 of the Distribution Licence. In effect, this means that the charges levied by Energetics Electricity for Use of System cannot exceed those charged by the local ex-PES Distribution Network Owner's (DNO's) network.

In order to satisfy this requirement, Energetics Electricity's charges are structured to match those of the local DNO's network. These charges may vary year to year as these DNO's set their use of system charges to recover their allowed revenue.

## **Distribution Use of System Charges**

Energetics Electricity will levy use of system charges for utilisation of its network for the supply of electricity to end users and/or the transportation of electricity across its network. Energetics Electricity's Use of System tariffs are published in our Use of System Charging Statements issued under Licence Condition 14.

## **The Contractual Framework**

Persons entitled to use Energetics Electricity's distribution system are those who are authorised by Licence or by exemption under the Act to supply, distribute or generate electricity. In order to protect all users of the system, Energetics Electricity will require evidence of authorisation before agreeing terms for use of the system.

Persons seeking to use the system will be required, prior to using the system, to enter into an agreement with Energetics Electricity setting out the obligations of both parties. The party seeking use of the system will be required to:

- pay all charges due in respect of use of the system as described in this statement and the accompanying schedules;
- be a party (where the user is a Licensed Supplier or a Licensed Distributor) to the Master Registration Agreement (MRA) for the provision of metering point administration services within Energetics Electricity's authorised area;
- enter into the National Grid Electricity Transmission (NGC) Connection and Use of System Code and any necessary Bilateral Agreement, governing connections to and use of NGC's transmission system, unless Energetics Electricity is informed by NGC that this is not required in any particular case;
- be a party to the Balancing and Settlements Code; and
- comply with the provisions of the Distribution Code.

If the applicant and Energetics Electricity fail to agree contractual terms, or any variation of contractual terms proposed by Energetics Electricity, either party may request settlement by Ofgem.

While the terms and conditions in the agreements will be consistent with those in this statement, the agreement will take precedence. Where an Authorised Electricity Operator, having entered into an agreement for use of Energetics Electricity's distribution system, ceases for whatever reason to be an Authorised Electricity Operator with respect to that use of the system, then the entitlement to use of the system will cease forthwith, but the operator will continue to be liable under the agreement unless and until the agreement is terminated.

In order to avoid any liability in this regard, an Authorised Electricity Operator wishing to terminate his agreement or wishing to notify a change should give Energetics Electricity no less than 28 days' notice. Energetics Electricity will normally respond within 28 days of a notification of change.
